**PRESS RELEASE**

The Elections and Boundaries Commission (Commission) informs of the appointment of Mr. Collet Montejo as a member of the Re-division Task Force as supervisor of all field work for the gathering and providing of all information for the consideration of the task force in regard to the transport and other facilities of the divisions and as to its physical features and the distribution of the population throughout Belize as per Section 90 (2) of the Belize Constitution. This field work will complement the work already being done by the technical experts in the areas of geographical information systems, legal studies, statistical analysis, and electoral management.

The task force is ultimately responsible to make recommendations to the Elections and Boundaries Commission. Upon receipt of recommendations from the task force, the Commission is solely responsible in compliance with Section 90 of the Belize Constitution to make proposals to the National Assembly for boundary redistricting.

The Commission continues to place high priority on this critical exercise which is expected to be concluded in the year 2023.
