Toledo West

Polling Area No. 120

Commencing at the intersection the Stann Creek/Toledo District boundary and Sapote Creek; thence upstream along said east bank of Sapote Creek for an approximate distance of 8.7 kilometers to its watershed with the Crique Salada; thence southerly and downstream along the west bank of Crique Salada for an approximate distance of 11 kilometers to its confluence with the Trio River, save and except the village of Trio; thence downstream along the west bank of the Trio River for an approximate distance of 13 kilometers to its confluence with the Bladen Branch of the Monkey River; thence downstream along the west bank of the Bladen Branch of the Monkey River for an approximate distance of 7 kilometers to its intersection with the southern highway, save and except the village of Bladen; thence southerly along the eastern side of the southern highway for an approximate distance of 49 kilometers to a point, the said point being the intersection of the southern highway and the Rio Grande River; thence downstream along the northern bank of Rio Grande to its confluence with an un-named creek; thence south westerly and upstream along the northern bank of said un-named creek to its intersection with San Marcos road; thence south westerly along the north said San Marcos road to its intersection with the Southern Highway; thence north west along Southern Highway to the first road junction on the left side of the highway; thence south west along the un named road to its confluence with Crique Piedra; thence south west along said Crique Piedra to its confluence with Mafredi Lagoon; thence southwesterly along said lagoon to its confluence with Mafredi Creek; thence north westerly and up stream along Mafredi Creek to its intersection with the Blue Creek road; thence north westerly along said Blue Creek road to its intersection with San Antonio road; thence north easterly along San Antonio road to its interception with San Pedro Colombia road; thence north along San Pedro Road to intersection with the south branch of the Columbia Branch river; thence down stream along the said Colombia Branch river to its confluence with Rio Grande; thence upstream along the said Rio Grande to its intersection with the Cayo/ Toledo District Boundary; thence northerly and easterly along the said district boundary back to the point of commencement.

The afore described Polling Area No. 120 generally comprising the villages of Medina Bank, Tambran, Golden Stream, Indian Creek, Hicattee, Big Falls and the Dump

Polling Area No. 120A

Commencing at the confluence of Rio Grande and an unnamed creek; thence downstream along the north bank of the Rio Grande to its confluence with Jacinto Creek; thence upstream in a south westerly direction along Jacinto Creek to its confluence with Papishaw Creek; thence up stream along the south banks of Papishaw Creek to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 299599 meters east and 1784745 meters north; thence south west in a straight line from said point to the San Felipe Road; thence continue south westerly along San Felipe road to its intersection with Moho River; thence upstream along the northern banks of the Moho River to its confluence with Black Creek; thence downstream along Black Creek to its confluence with Mafredi Lagoon; thence continue along the eastern bank of said lagoon to its confluence with Cirque Piedra; thence downstream along Crique Piedra to the its intersection with an unnamed major track; thence north east along said track to its junction with Southern Highway; thence south east on the Southern Highway to its junction with San Marcos Road; thence continue north east along San Marcos road to its intersection with an un named creek; thence north east along the said creek back to point of commencement.

The afore described Polling Area 120A generally comprising of Laguna, Jacintoville, San Felipe, Yemeri Grove and San Marcos

Polling Area No. 121

Commencing at a point, the said point being the intersection of a trail and the Belize/Guatemala international boundary and having a scaled UTM coordinate of 265370 meters east and 1810252 meters north; thence to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 268888 meters east and 1810288 meters north; thence east a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 278221 meters east and 1808002 meters north and being on the Colombia Branch; thence downstream along the north banks of the said Colombia Branch to where it intersect with the San Pedro Colombia road; thence south along the San Pedro Columbia road to its junction with San Antonio Road; thence westerly along the San Antonio Road to its junction with Blue Creek road; thence south west along the Blue Creek Road to its intersection with Blue Creek; thence upstream along Blue Creek to its intersection with San Antonio Road/ Santa Cruz road; thence east along the said road to its intersection with the road that lead to San Jose; thence north west along the said San Jose road to the village of San Jose; thence west along the road leading out of the San Jose village to where it intersect with a un-named creek; thence westerly and upstream along the un-named creek to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 269960 meters east and 1802975 meters north; thence west to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 264841 meters east and 1802975 meters north on the international border between Belize and Guatemala; thence northerly along said international border back to the point of commencement.

The afore described Polling Area No. 121 generally comprising all settlements from mile 17 to San Antonio on the Punta Gorda/San Antonio Road and including Crique Arena, Mafredi, San Antonio, Crique Jute, San Jose (Hawaii), Crique Troso, Colombia Branch, Crique Lagart and Nah Luum Ca.

Polling Area No. 122

Commencing at the junction where Rio Grande intersect with the Cayo/Toledo District Boundary; thence downstream along the northern bank of Rio Grand to its confluence with Colombia Branch; thence upstream along the said Colombia Branch to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 278221 meters east and 1808002 meters; thence to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 268888 meters east and 1810288 meters north; thence to a point having having a scaled UTM coordinate of 265370 meters east and 1810252 meters north, the said point being on the international boundary between Belize and Guatemala; thence northerly along the said international boundary to the Cayo/Toledo District Boundary; thence northerly and easterly along said district boundary back to the point of commencement.

The afore described Polling Area No. 122 generally comprising the villages of San Miguel and San Pedro Colombia.

Polling Area No. 123

Commencing from a point, the said point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 264841 meters east and 1802975 meters north on the international border between Belize and Guatemala; thence east to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 269960 meters east and 1802975 meters north where it intersect with an un-named creek; thence down stream along said creek until it intersects with a road west of San Jose; thence south east along said road to San Jose Village; thence south east along San Jose road to Santa Cruz Village; thence west along the said road to its junction Blue Creek; thence downstream along Blue Creek to it intersect with a secondary road that comes from Mafredi; thence continue south west along said road to its intersection with Aguacate Creek; thence upstream the northern bank of Aguacate Creek to a point having a scaled UTM

coordinate of 262624 meters east and 1788600 meters north in an area known as the sink; thence continue south west along the sink to a point having a scaled UTM of 263531 meters east and 1785710 meters north and being on the international boundary between Belize and Guatemala; thence northerly along said international boundary back to the point of commencement.

The afore described Polling Area No. 123 generally comprising the villages of San Vicente, Jalacte, Pueblo Viejo, Santa Cruz, and Santa Elena.

Poling Area No. 124

Commencing at a point, the said point being where the Temash River intersects with the international boundary between Belize and Guatemala; thence downstream along northern bank of said Temash River for a distance of 7 kilometers to its junction with a major track; thence north east along western side of major track to its intersection with Moho River; thence downstream Moho River to its confluence with Blue Creek and Black Creek; thence upstream Black Creek to its confluence with Mafredi Lagoon; thence along the said Mafredi Lagoon to its confluence with Mafredi Creek; thence upstream Mafredi Creek to its intersection with the Mafredi/Blue Creek road; thence south west along said road to its intersection with Aguacate Creek; thence upstream Aguacate Creek to a point having a scaled UTM coordinate of 262624 meters east and 1788600 meters north, and being in an area known as the sink; thence south west along the sink to its intersection with the international boundary between Belize and Guatemala and having scaled UTM of 263531 meters east and 1785710 meters north; thence continue in a southerly direction along the said international boundary back to the point of commencement.

The afore described Polling Area No. 124 generally comprising of the villages of Aguacate, Blue Creek, Jordan, Mabilha, Machaca, San Benito Poite, and Santa Teresa.
