The following services will be provided:

1. Accepting applications for change from one electoral division to another;
  2. Accepting applications for registration of electors; **and**
  3. Delivery of voters identification cards
1. Electors wishing to apply for change of electoral division to their respective villages:
    - Must be registered electors since 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018; **and**
    - Must be residing in their respective village for at least two months or more

❖ Electors are encouraged to bring along either of the following to facilitate the process.

- Voters Identification Card; **or**
- Social Security Card; **or**
- Driver's License

2. Persons wishing to apply to be registered as electors are required to produce any of the following valid original documents:

- Belizean Birth Certificate, or Belize Nationality Certificate, along with (Social Security Card or photograph certified, stamped and signed by a Justice of the Peace); **or**
- Belizean Passport; **or**
- Commonwealth Passport (for Commonwealth Citizens)

3. Persons who have been registered as electors since 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018 and have not yet picked up their voters identification card can pick up their identification cards during these days.

Residents of these respective villages are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity.
